




The Cookie-Dough Bake-Off

Somebody had to sample all the **ready-to-bake chocolate-chip cookies** on the market and find the best ones. Real Simple's testers made the sacrifice

These cookies need no embellishment, but if you're in the mood for some fabulous excess, drizzle them with melted white, milk, or dark chocolate or crumble them over ice cream or pudding.



600 LB. GORILLAS CHOCOLATE CHIP

The closest to made-fromscratch, hands down. The rich, buttery flavor and soft, chewy consistency even when the cookies were cool—drew raves. Unlike most brands, this one has no trans fats or preservatives. **DETAILS:** \$4 for 18 frozen preshaped cookies. CHOCOLATE CHUNK These cookies had the

perfect ratio of chocolate to cookie. Testers found them to be almost—but not quite—too sweet. They cooled to a crisp, making them great for dunking.

NESTLÉ TOLLHOUSE ULTIMATES CHOCOLATE CHIP LOVERS

Packed with both chips and larger chunks, these cookies barely had enough batter to hold the chocolate together. "Gooey but without that underbaked taste," one tester said. An excellent choice for chocoholics.
